Institutional views on learner centric education

a)Multidisciplinary education



Our college has already adopted the multidisciplinary education by adopting three courses of PSOU (mushroom cultivation ,creative writing and business entrepreneurship)

The college invites the resource persons from various areas to share information with the students So that they can pursue different careers according to the area of their interest.

Plans which can be adopted to accomplish this aim

To achieve the aim of learner centric education the students will be made to _

- 1.Interview the people outside of one's discipline. The students can interact with the entrepreneurs of the nearby mushroom cultivation units so that they can practically learn the ways to adopt it as their career and the same will help in the placement of them in the same field.
- 2.Interacting with students to know their area of interest so that new parallel courses can be adopted by the college to help students in self dependency.
- 3.The college will hold competitions for students in various fields (arts ,science ,sports) from time to time so that they know their capabilities .

Adoption of academic bank of credits (ABC)



- Installing digilocker
- The students will be informed about the Digilocker application which they can easily install in their mobile phones to get a specific ID which will be required to have an account in academic bank of credits.
- NEP(National education policy) 2020 has adopted ABC
- The credits that the students obtain in their first and second year will be stored using the Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) system. So, at any point of time, if students want to take a break and continue their course within a fixed period, they can utilise these credits for further education.

ADOPTION OF MULTIPLE ENTRY AND EXIT SYSTEM

- The system will allow students to take a sabbatical(break) and then join back their studies without losing any credits. The move will allow students to build their own degrees. Students shall be granted more autonomy than before to decide what kind of major and minor courses they want to pursue.
- This is likely to revolutionise higher education system in India as only interested students will complete the degree through multiple entry and exit point system. Those who are not interested to pursue the course shall have no compulsion to complete the same by all means

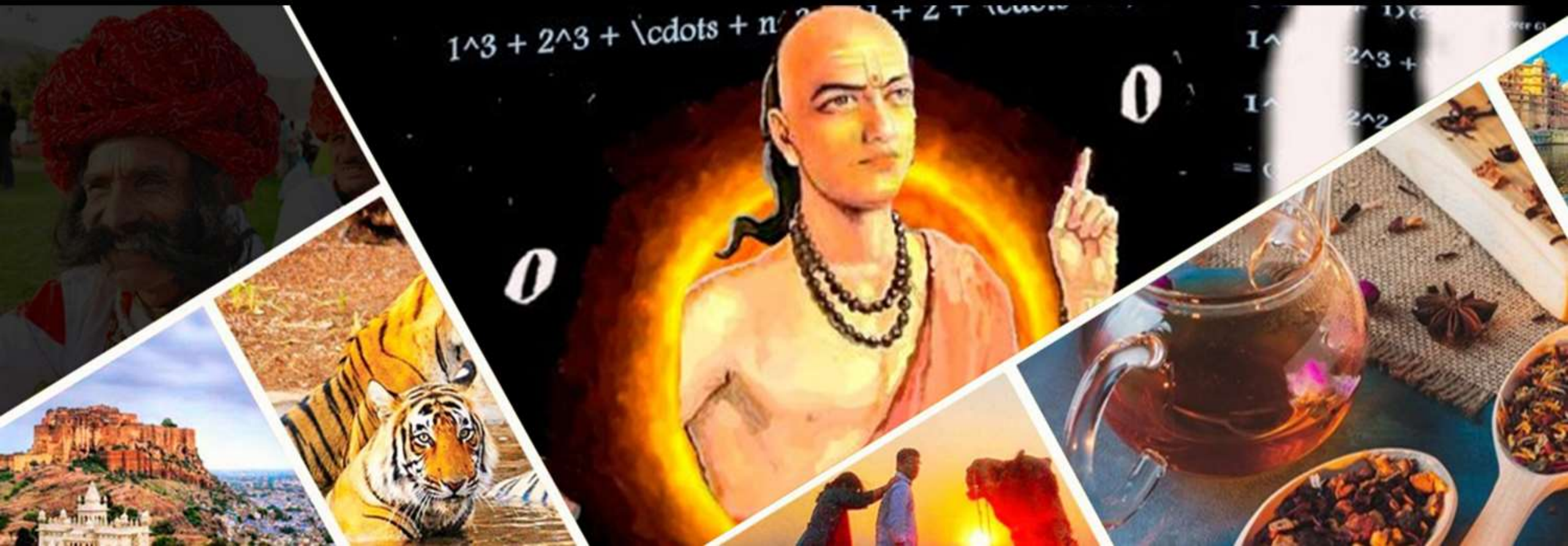
